Ages: 6-13 (Must be 6 years old by June 23, 2024)

Cost(plus tax): Day Camp tuition includes a uniform, weekly field trips, and daily lunch.

- \$1,150 per week without transportation
- \$1,450 per week with transportation

Sibling discount: A 5% discount will be applied to each child after the first registered. *Note: Siblings will be eligible for this discount if they are registered and attend the same week.* The discount will also be applied as a credit at the end of the summer to your statement.

Deposit: A \$150 non-refundable deposit is required for each week registered. This will confirm your child's spot and will be applied to your member statement at the time of registration. The deposit will be applied to the total cost of the tuition.

Payment: Day camp tuition will be posted in full to your member statement on June 3rd.

Calendar of Field Trips: Coming soon

Times: Monday-Friday 9am-3pm

- Morning Dropoff: Campers should plan to arrive 10 minutes before the start of camp to ensure they are ready for the day. Parents/guardians will need to sign in their camper at the start of every day.
- Afternoon Pickup: Dismissal will be at 3pm. Campers are not permitted to leave unless signed out by a parent/guardian. Note: Children under the age of 14 years old are not permitted to be on Travers Island property unless accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- Field Trips: All field trips will take place during day camp hours. In the event there is a delay on the return to Travers Island , WFDC families will be notified.

Transportation:

- Morning Pickup: Buses will begin picking up children at 7:15am and will be brought to Travers Island in time for the start of camp.
- Afternoon Dropoff: Buses will begin dropping of children at 3:15pm. For more details regarding transportation polices, please see the "Day Camp Policies" on the next page

REGISTRATION

- Spots are limited. Registration will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis.
- All policies for Youth Programs at the NYAC remain in effect, such as a valid medical form and completed waivers must be submitted prior to participation.
- Siblings must be registered for the same week for Day Camp to have access to transportation.
- Cancellations or adjustments to registration must be made by **May 24th**. Requests for cancellations or adjustments may be sent to <u>daycamp@nyac.org</u>.
 - Cancellations to registration made **before May 24th**, may be refunded with any fees paid thus far, except for the \$150 non-refundable deposit per week cancelled.
 - Refunds will not be permitted **after May 24th**.
 - Adjustments to registration including, but not limited to switching weeks and transportation logistics after May 24th, will be subject to an administrative fee.
- A waitlist will be formed in the event that a specific week becomes full. Notification of the waitlist will be sent via e-mail by the Day Camp Director.

TRANSPORTATION

- Pickup and dropoff locations must be submitted at the time of registration. Cancellations or adjustments to the bus route must be made by **May 24**, and emailed to <u>daycamp@nyac.org</u>. Any cancellations or adjustments to the bus route made after the deadline will be subject to an administrative fee.
- Parents/guardians must be at the pickup and dropoff location each day their child is registered. Names must be listed in the "Authorized pickup/dropoff contact" section of the registration. Parents/guardians must present a valid form of identification to the staff member on board.
 - \circ Additional authorized contacts must be at least 18 years old.
 - Last minute authorization requests may be considered 24-48 hours before the pickup and dropoff. All authorization requests will be confirmed by the Day Camp Director.
- Failure to have an authorized adult present or a valid for of identification at the pickup and dropoff location will result in the child being brought to the City House and will be subject to a late pickup fee.

GUESTS

• Guests are not permitted to attend the Winged Foot Day Camp.

MEDICAL FORM/CONSENT FORM

• Waivers and valid medical forms, including a physical and immunization record with a signature or stamp from a doctor's office, are required to be submitted prior to participating.
