## Swimming - US Open Underway in Greensboro

Wednesday, December 4th – Saturday, December 7th; Greensboro, NC – The NYAC's Drew Kibler, Paris 2024 Olympic silver medalist in the 4x200m freestyle, took second in the 50yd freestyle at the <u>Toyota US Open</u> on Thursday night with a finish of 19.49. Brady Samuels, Purdue University senior, won in 19.33, and Shane Eckler, Notre Dame freshman, took third in 19.68. Previously in the heats, Kibler won heat #4 with the fastest finish of the heats (19.48). Fellow NYAC competitor **Michael Kincheloe** also contested the 50yd freestyle but did not advance beyond the heats, where he swam a time of 21.02. More competition is to come over the next two days in Greensboro, where Kibler is set to contest the 200yd freestyle A final on Friday night and the 100yd freestyle heats on Saturday. **Click here** for the results thus far from Greensboro, and check next week's installment of the Athletics News for the remainder.
