

## Road Running - Pearson Sets NYAC Half Marathon Record in Houston



Sunday, January 19th; Houston, Texas – In cold and blustery conditions at last Sunday's Houston Half Marathon, the NYAC's Morgan Pearson, a two-time Olympic silver medalist in the triathlon mixed relay, set a personal best of 1:01:01, the fastest half marathon ever run by an NYAC athlete. That time pruned seven seconds from Pearson's own Club record, which he had set on the super-fast Valencia course last year. The depth of the field in Houston was such that such a blistering time saw Pearson place 15th, victory going to Ethiopia's Addisu Gobena who out-leaned the USA's Paris Olympian, Conner Mantz, both crossing the line in 59:17. Mantz' clocking was a new US record, eclipsing the 59:43 of Ryan Hall, set in 2007. For all the results from the Houston Half Marathon click here.

## Track and Field - Nilsen Victorious in South Dakota

**Saturday, January 18th; Vermillion, South Dakota** – The NYAC's **Chris Nilsen**, Tokyo 2020 Olympic pole vault silver medalist, won that event at the <u>University of South Dakota Alumni Meet</u> last weekend with a mark of 5.80m/19-00.25. South Dakota Coyotes Eerik Haamer and Spencer Buley took second (5.37m/17-07.25) and third (5.22m/17-

01.50), respectively. Nilsen, who grew up in Kansas City, Missouri, graduated from the University of South Dakota in 2020 with a degree in kinesiology and sport management. Christie placed third in 2:45:31 to Sweden's Perseus Karlstrom (2:27:19), with Mexico's Ever Palma second (2:37:46).
