# Rugby Sevens - US Men Defeat Argentina in Perth Pool Play

Friday, January 24th - Sunday, January 26th; Perth, Australia - The US men recorded a win against Argentina, 24-19, during Pool A play at the HSBC Rugby Sevens Perth stop and losses to South Africa (19-24, Pool A). Australia (12-19, Pool A), Kenya (21-26, 9th Place Semi Final) and Ireland (17-19, 11th Place Play-Off). In the win against Argentina, the NYAC's Steve Tomasin achieved two conversions. With three stops completed and three to go (Vancouver on 2/21-2/23, Hong Kong on 3/28-3/30, and Singapore on 4/5-4/6), the US men are in 11th place in the standings with five points. Fiji, Argentina, and Spain are in first, second, and third, respectively, each with 48 points. The top eight teams at the conclusion of the Singapore round in April will advance to a winner-takes-all Grand Final in Madrid in May. Click here for full results from Perth.

# Track and Field - Price Victorious at Fighting Illini Challenge

Friday, January 24th - Saturday, January 25th; Champaign, IL - The NYAC's Deanna Price, 2019 world champion in the hammer throw, won the weight throw competition at the Fighting Illini Challenge with a mark of 75-10 1/4/23.12m. Price has served as an assistant throws coach at the University of Illinois, host of the meet, since 2022, and her athletes, Phethisang Makhethe' and Jordan Koskondy finished second (70-6 1/2/21.50m) and third (69-4/21.13m), respectively, in the competition.
