



Paris 2024 - Maybe the Best Ever



The Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in Paris were filled with New York Athletic Club highlights, with discus thrower Valarie Allman claiming her second consecutive gold medal, with wrestler Sarah Hildebrandt adding a gold to the bronze that she won in Tokyo, and with Kate Douglass emerging as one of the stars of the US swimming team, claiming two gold medals and two silvers. Those are just a few of countless memorable moments. The NYAC's tally of 30 medals - 10 gold, 13 silver and seven bronze - is second only in the Club's history to the numbers achieved in the St Louis Games of 1904. 

All of them have claimed Paralympics medals in the past (three for Woodhall, one for Brannigan, two for Norman and 19 for McFadden, not counting her Winter Games silver) and the portents are excellent that those numbers will increase once the Para Games begin in less than two week's time.
